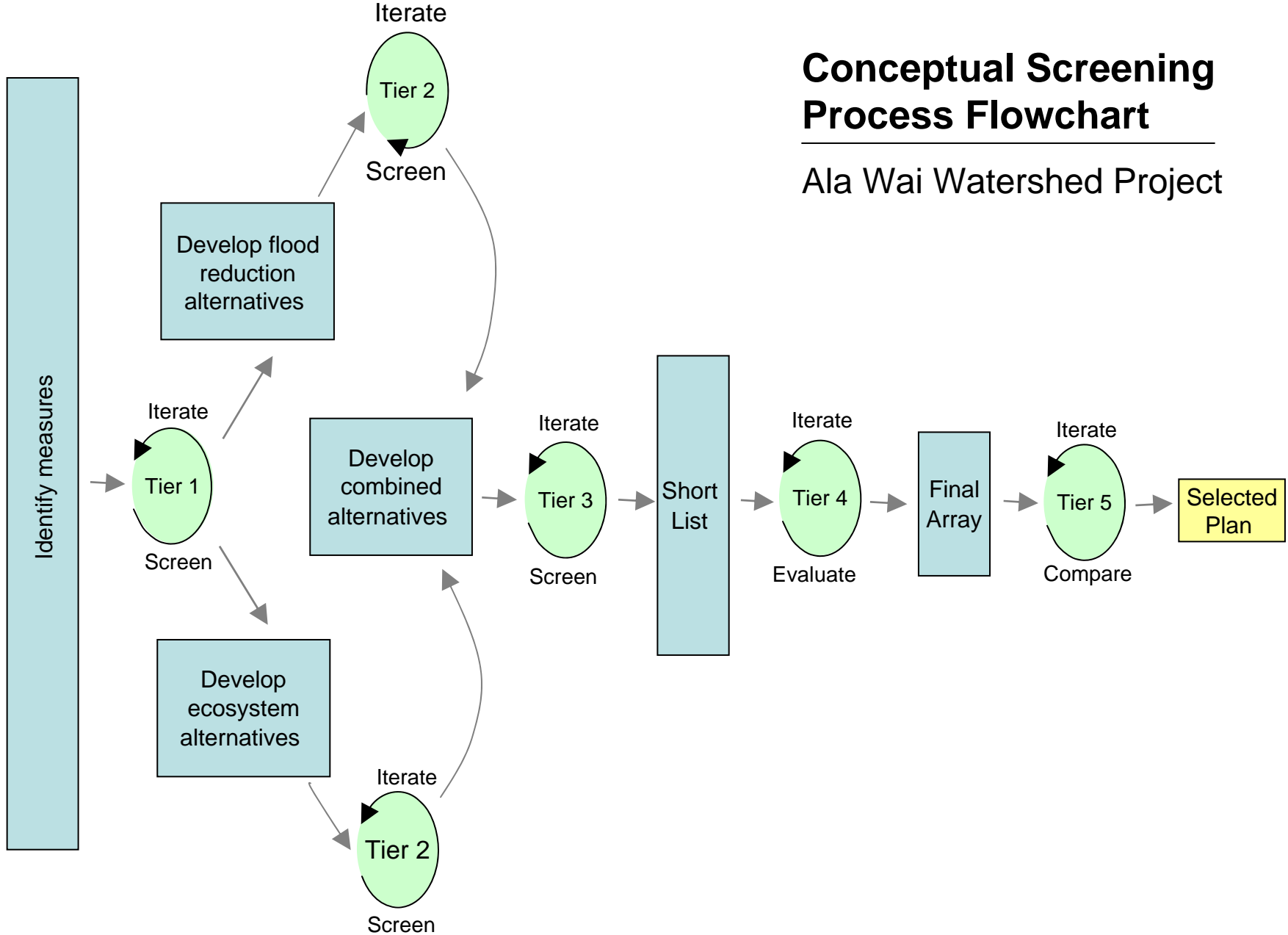


Conceptual Screening Process Flowchart
